accomplish / altitude / avalanche / excavate / guardian / monarch / pasture / resemble / route / summit

accomplish

(verb) To complete; to succeed in doing something. *Because of the bad weather, we weren't able to accomplish much yard work today.*

Other forms: Getting all A's is a pretty big accomplishment (noun).

altitude

(noun) Height above the Earth's surface (usually above sea level on the Earth's surface). *Due to the plane's high altitude, we could see the entire island all at once.*

avalanche

(noun) A great mass of rocks, dirt, snow, or ice sliding down a mountainside. *Run! It's an avalanche!*

excavate

(verb) To dig out. *Digging into the ground very carefully, Leo and his team excavated three giant ruby-covered shields.*

Other forms: The scientists worked for months at the excavation (noun) site before finding any bones.

guardian

(noun) One who protects or guards. *When it came to dealing with older boys, Vinny's oldest brother Tony was his guardian.*

monarch

(noun) A king, queen, or emperor; someone who rules a kingdom. *Lili'uokalani was the last monarch of the kingdom of Hawaii.*

Other forms: In France, the citizens rose up and overthrew the monarchy (noun).

pasture

(noun) A field of growing grass where animals can eat; a meadow. *Wandering through the pasture, the sheep felt lonely.*

resemble

(verb) To look like or be similar to. *Have you ever noticed that a staple kind of resembles a trombone?*

Other forms: Robby and his brother share a strong resemblance (noun).



excavate

(noun) The path that must be followed to get to a place. We took the scenic route to our cousin's house and got to see some cool cliffs.

summit

(noun) The highest part: the top. Tenzing Norgay and Edmund Hillary were the first people to reach the summit of Mount Everest.
